Cynthia Emiry Roy has grown the Regional Hospice and Palliative Care in Danbury from a small business to an \$18 million corporation. The 36,000-square-foot Center for Comfort Care and Healing that opened in 2015 offers 12 patient suites, each with space for family members to sleep. The center also provides gourmet catering service from the kitchen, a library, chapel, spa and play scape for children, as well as administrative offices. It is a fully licensed specialty care hospital and the only facility of its kind in Connecticut. In addition to the center, Regional Hospice and Palliative Care also provides hospice care in four counties to people in homes, skilled nursing facilities and assisted living facilities.
