Comprehensive Exam:

Students will choose a committee of three full-time faculty members of the department. Part-time faculty or faculty from other departments or other universities must be approved by the program coordinator. The scope and nature of the comprehensive exam will be determined by the committee.

Transfer to Thesis Option:

A student can transfer to the thesis option, with approval of the graduate coordinator, without penalty or loss of credit.

Grade Point Average:

A student must have a grade point average of at least 3.00 in order to take the comprehensive exam, and to graduate.

Time Limit:

A student must complete the degree requirements within 6 years of being admitted to the program. Courses older than 10 years at the time of the comprehensive exam will not count toward the degree.

Inactivity:

A student who does not register for three consecutive semesters will be withdrawn from the program and must apply for readmission.
