Roommate requests must be mutual to be considered. Requests for indicated preferences are not guaranteed. Transfer or current students applying for housing may request up to four roommates for suites or apartments.

I understand that by choosing the Gender Neutral Housing option, I am responsible to abide by any and all policies, procedures, and/or decisions made by Housing and Residence Life at all times. I understand that the participation in, policies of, and procedures for this housing option can and will be modified at any time to meet the needs of the University and Housing. Continued participation in this housing option is at the will of the University and Housing only.

I understand the additional financial implications that choosing this housing option brings. Students who select the gender neutral housing option must be able to fill an entire suite or apartment with the university-defined occupancy (4 per apartment in Grasso, or 5 per apartment in Pinney.) This means that there will be an eligible student applying for every bed in the suite or apartment. Housing and Residence Life will not assign partial groups (those who cannot fill an entire suite or apartment) to gender neutral housing. If a roommate in a gender neutral suite or apartment cancels his/her housing or moves out of the suite or apartment for any reason, the remaining roommates must identify a new roommate to fill the vacancy. Housing & Residence Life will define the time allotted to find a new roommate, depending on the time of year and status of housing applications. Typically, this will be not more than one week. If the vacancy cannot be filled by the students assigned to the suite within that timeframe, Housing & Residence Life will fill the space with another student who has requested gender neutral housing. If no student is available to fill the space, **the remaining students will be billed for the vacant space** in the current suite or apartment, the prorated cost to be divided evenly among the remaining residents.

This is an application for space and does **not** guarantee a specific or Gender Neutral assignment. **WCSU reserves the right to assign and reassign students to the various residence halls or rooms according to the needs of the department and based on availability.**

My signature below indicates my understanding of and agreement to following any and all rules, regulations, policies and procedures set forth by the University and the Department of Housing and Residence Life. In addition to this application, I understand that I am required to attach and follow all requirements and statements set forth in the Housing Contract.

In order for this application to be considered valid, current WCSU students must be eligible for Room Selection and submit their Housing Contract with this application. Students new to the university or currently not in housing must complete a Housing Application/Contract and submit it with this form to be considered for Gender Neutral Housing.
