

General Education Requirements (42 S.H.)

Choose one of the following: COM 160 Public Speaking, COM 161 Decision Making in Groups, COM 162 Interpersonal Communication **or** COM 163 Introduction to Communication Skills

WRITING INTENSIVE (W)

All students must complete at least one writing intensive course. W courses can be found in several disciplines. The credits will be counted in the discipline associated with the course. **NOTE:** WRT101 does not satisfy the writing intensive requirement.

FOREIGN LANGUAGE

All majors must complete a foreign language requirement. This may be done by completing a language at an elementary II level or above. Students who have completed three years of language in high school with at least a C average have satisfied this requirement. (For more info, click the link above.)

HUMANITIES (9 S.H.)

Including 3 of 6 categories: Communications, Foreign Language, Humanistic Studies, Literature, Philosophy, and Western History. You must complete courses in at least three areas. **NOTE:** *You must complete the foreign language requirement (Elementary II or higher) before counting Elementary I foreign language courses as Humanities credit.*

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SOCIAL AND BEHAVIORAL SCIENCES (12 S.H.)

Courses that satisfy this requirement can be found in Social Sciences (Anthropology, Economics, Geography, Political Science, Social Sciences, and Sociology), Non-Western Cultures, and Psychology. You must select courses from at least 2 of the 3 main areas: Social Sciences, Psychology and Non-Western Cultures.
