

A minor in Philosophy requires 18 PHI credits, **including at least 9 credits at the 200-level or above**, at least one course in logic, at least one course in the history of philosophy, and at least one course in ethics. Courses in logic, history of philosophy and ethics must be chosen from the lists below; all current PHI courses can be applied toward the remaining 9 elective credits. Students must maintain a 2.0 minimum GPA and must complete 9 credits of the minor at Western.
