

WCSU Master's Degree in Counselor Education Program Outcomes 2022-23

Program Goal	Student Outcomes
1. The WCSU Counselor Education Program provides students with the knowledge and skills to be successful professional counselors.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 97% of students who took the National Counselor Exam passed • 100% of school counseling students in the Class of 2023 received certifications from CT, NY or both states. • 100% of students received proficient or higher on program key assessments on counseling and group skills and 87% on career counseling skills.
2. The WCSU Counselor Education Program prepares students to consider each client as unique, multi-dimensional individuals, throughout the counseling relationship.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 87% of students scored proficient or higher in the ability to provide culturally responsive counseling on the Fieldwork Assessment. • 89% and 100% of students scored proficient or higher in the ability to select and interpret assessments through a culturally sensitive lens in Fieldwork Assessment and on the Assessment Performance Task respectively.
3. The WCSU Counselor Education program assures students have developed dispositions aligned with the legal, ethical, and humanistic parameters of the American Counseling Association and/or the American School Counseling Association.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 100% of the Class of 2023 scored a 1 (possess appropriate dispositions) on the Fitness to Practice Tool. • 90% of practicum and internship students scored proficient or higher in their ability to function as professional counselors by supervisors on the Fieldwork Assessment.
